As a materials analyst, Living Product Assessor and Declare third-party verifier for the International Living Future Institute, Anjanette is among an elite group of experts working to bring healthier products to market. Anjanette has worked tirelessly with a wide spectrum of manufacturers assessing ingredients in supply chains and advocating for the removal of chemicals of concern that contribute to poor health and unhealthy air quality.

To date, Anjanette has employed biomimetic design and green chemistry to replace some of our most onerous chemicals of concern ubiquitous to the building and construction industry.
